She has exhibited widely in numerous countries, including intervals spent, over a seven-year period, living and working in China, and selling her scarves across the counter in Liberty and exhibiting in Harrods. Working with dancers has been a feature throughout, endlessly curious, mixing cultures and media, like photography, film, drawing and painting. And a deep-seated commitment to Community Arts since the 1960s has seen her running workshops, festivals, and residencies, with unabated passion, dedication, and hard-work.
